- 1. All bookings are subject to Westminster Kingsway College's standard booking Terms and Conditions.
- 2. The minimum session duration is 8 hours. Additional hours may be available at extra cost, but must be booked in advance.
- 3. The copyright in all materials generated from a session will reside with Westminster Kingsway College until such time as all costs of hire and extras relating to that session are paid for in full with cleared funds. Additionally, all recorded material will be stored and backed-up for a period of up to a month from the session date, after which time all files will be deleted.
- 4. By hiring the studio you agree to pay for the cost of the repair or replacement of any items damaged by any member of your party during your session.
- 5. If for any reason there is a period of technical downtime during your session, you will be credited with any lost time.
- 6. Although the pianos are regularly maintained, it is highly recommended that the pianos are tuned specifically for your session. This can be arranged for an additional charge of £60.
- 7. It is your responsibility to supply any consumables (CDs, batteries, guitar strings etc.) and any external storage media.
- 8. You hereby acknowledges that the Noise at Work Regulations 1989 have established that prolonged exposure to high noise levels above 85dB(A) may cause damage to hearing and that both studios and studio users are required by law to keep exposures as low as reasonably practicable.
